



Summary of Changes Report – September 2010

Initial Management of Abnormal Cervical Cytology (Pap Test) and HPV Test in Adult and Adolescent Females Guideline

Algorithm

The algorithms Atypical Squamous Cells of Undetermined Significance (ASCUS) and Atypical Glandular Cells (AGC) have been revised.

Introduction

A statement related to colposcopy for LSIL during pregnancy was added with references (*American College of Obstetrician and Gynecologist, 2008*), (*Boardman, 2005*) and (*Cristoforoni, 1999*).

Annotations

The annotations were renumbered according to algorithm changes.

- 18) A reference was added to support subheadings for the classification of AGC. (*Lai, 2007*)
- 23) Information related to the timing of colposcopy for post-menopausal patients diagnosed with LSIL was added.
- 31) A key point was added stating HPV testing should not be used for adolescents. A key point was added stating screening before age 21 is not recommended.

Aims & Measures

All Aims and Measures were revised to pertain only to women age 21 and older.

- 1b) The measure specific to adolescents with LSIL and ASCUS was deleted.
- 3) The measure related to reducing psychological distress by increasing knowledge was deleted and replaced with a measure specific to women with a LSIL result.
