

The 2010 revision of this guideline focused on Annotations #12 through #22. Other revisions/updates were made based on the Women's Health Steering Committee, August 2009 suggestions or recent changes in the evidence.

For ease of use, the topical index was expanded and topics were listed by page number rather than algorithm number.

Algorithm/Table

Depression was added to Screening Maneuvers for Visit 3, deleted from Visit 4 and added to Visit 5.

“Psychosocial risk factors” was added to Counseling, Education and Intervention category in Week 5.

Clinical Highlights

The clinical highlight language regarding counseling for aneuploidy screening was revised.

Annotations

- #2) Additional language was added re: the consideration of weight reduction for obese women prior to conception. The references *Practice Committee of the American Society for Reproductive Medicine, 2008*, and *Moos, 2008* were added.
- #4) The gonorrhea statistics in the Risk Profile Screening section were updated. The reference *CDC, 2008* was added.
- #5) A Bariatric Surgery section was added re: the consideration of pregnancy after surgery. The references *ACOG, 2005*; *Guelinckx, 2009*; *Sheiner, 2004*; *Moore, 2004* and *ACOG, 2009a* were added.
- #11) The annotation on Depression was updated to include additional factors associated with the likelihood of postpartum depression. The reference *Lancaster, 2010* was added.

- #12) Patient education of bleeding and spotting risk factors was added to Preterm Labor Education and Prevention. The reader is referred to the March of Dimes resource on preterm labor risk, which was added at the end of this section. Cervical assessment with sonography and/or with digital examination was revised. References *Iams, 1999*, and *Owen, 2009* were added.
- #13) A cross-reference to Annotation #25 Nutritional Supplements was added as well as a resource for additional information re: drugs in pregnancy. The reference *Briggs, 2008* was added.
- #15) Folic acid supplementation recommendations were revised. Reference to *Lawrence, 2006* was added.
- #16) Additional information re: the forms of supplemental iron were added and recommendations for daily iron in divided doses were included. References *Hoffman, 2000 and CDC, 2002* were added.
- #17) The ongoing research re: Rh genotyping from maternal assay was added to ABO/Rh/Ab. Reference to *Geifman-Holzman, 2006* was added.
- #20) HIV management language was revised to reflect current recommendations from ACOG. The reference to *ACOG, 2008* was added.
- #22) The work group revised the wording re: the recommendations on VBAC.
- #25) Additional Vitamin D supplementation was included. *Dawodu, 2003; Saadi, 2007; Yu, 2009*, were added as references.
- #27) New “Influenza” and “Tetanus/Pertussis” headers were added for ease of topic identification. Recommendations on influenza vaccines in pregnancy were enhanced and additional information on H1N1 was also included. References *Saleeby, 2009; Creanga, 2009; Jamieson, 2009* were added.
- #29) The Ultrasound annotation was reworked extensively re: the ongoing controversy of utility of ultrasounds and the optimal timing to obtain useful clinical data. New references include *Martin, 2003; Crane, 1994; Grandjean, 1999; Leivo, 1996; Bricker, 2008, and ACOG, 2006b*.
- #32) Gestational Diabetes Mellitus also was revised extensively to include information re: undiagnosed type 2 diabetes mellitus after abnormal glucose tolerance screening and that the HgbA1c is not a useful test in this regard. References include *Jovanic, 1984; ACOG 2001; ADA, 2010; Bevier, 1999; and Radder, 2005*.
