Revised level wording to better clarify what providers and care systems must/should/could or not do regarding assessing the need and offering services to patients. Added information about patient knowledge, decision aids and shared decision making.

- *2) Alcohol Abuse – Revised intake amounts for healthy women and men.

Aspirin Chemoprophylaxis Counseling – Revised section based on new evidence: U.S. Preventive Services Task Force, 2009 and Berger, 2006.

Breast Cancer Screening – Clarified statement for women younger than age 50 and older than age 75. Referenced a new Conclusion Grading Worksheet.

Cervical Cancer Screening – Revised statement about screening women age 65 and older. Cited additional evidence: Blanks, 2009; Rebolj, 2009; Armaroli, 2008; Flannelly, 2004.

Tobacco cessation – Revised section for consistency with child and adolescent guideline. Added new reference: U.S. Preventive Services Task Force, 2009.

Vision Screening – Moved to a Level II service.

- *3) Folic Acid Chemoprophylaxis Counseling – Expanded folic acid consumption to 400-800 micrograms and added a new reference (Wolff, 2009).

Osteoporosis Screening – Simplified screening based on U.S. Preventive Services Task Force recommendation (2002) and omitted counseling messages due to lack of evidence.

Vision Screening – Clarified age as adults age 65 and older and updated efficacy based on new reference (Chou, 2009).

- *4) Anxiety and Stress Counseling – Omitted due to lack of evidence.

Sexually Transmitted Infection Counseling – Updated based on new literature (Lin, 2008).

Skin Cancer Screening and Counseling – Updated based on new literature (Wolff, 2009).

- 5) Diabetes Routine Screening – Clarified statement that recommendation applies to patients who are at low risk for diabetes, and that a risk assessment should be the basis for this determination.
- 6) Added content on clinical decision support and decision aids.
