



Summary of Changes Report – October 2007

Preventive Services for Children and Adolescents

Algorithm, Clinical Highlights, Annotations

ICSI has updated its guideline template and these changes are reflected in the current guideline.

Level III and Level IV description language clarified.

Algorithm and tables updated based on annotation changes

Introduction: Prevention Visit Schedules paragraph clarified.

The new Immunization table and recommendations have been incorporated into the guideline.

*4 Chlamydia Screening counseling messages removed, as they are currently in the other sexually transmitted infection counseling section.

*5 Cervical Cancer Screening recommendation changed to reflect that screening should begin after three years after initiating sexual intercourse or age 21, whichever is sooner.

Tobacco Use Screening, prevention and intervention in adolescents, added statement regarding non-users to continue non-use of tobacco products. Added clarifying statement about what tobacco includes.

*5a Added clarifying language in the annotation box regarding how to approach Level III services.

Blood Lead Screening moved to Level III based on changes in the evidence. Work group now recommends that blood lead screening not be done for average risk population. New literature added from Preventive Services Task Force (USPSTF).

Developmental/Behavioral Assessment Testing, added new section on social development screening.

Domestic Violence and Abuse Screening and Counseling updated reference from USPSTF.

Injury Prevention Counseling on Bicycle Safety, Poisoning, Choking, Falls and Firearms moved to a Level III service. Counseling Messages moved to an appendix.

Iron Deficiency Screening recommendation updated.

Sexually Transmitted Infection Screening, updated work group recommendation based on U.S. Preventive Service Task Force and CDC recommendations around HIV testing.

Added new annotation on Undescended Testicle Screening.

*5b Child Maltreatment Screening moved from a Level III service to a Level IV service based on efficacy statement.

Hemoglobin updated reference from U.S. Preventive Services Task Force.

Deleted Lipid Assessment under age two, as no reference to support statement and it is implied in the dyslipidemia screening section.

Tuberculin Skin Testing added references.

Priority Aims & Suggested Measures, Measurement Specifications

- 2a: Specification includes indication if service as completed, offered and refused, or not done.
- 4: Changed aim to decreasing percentage of patients who are behind in their immunizations.
- 5: Deleted aim and suggested measure around cervical cancer screening, as it is a Level II service.

Support for Implementation

Omitted a Key Implementation Recommendation on risk assessment questionnaires, as it was redundant with others.

Updated the “Resources Available” table.
