

### **Algorithms**

Box 76 had ergotamine removed as a bridging option.

Box 77 renamed to Maintenance Prophylaxis and the generic name for Depakote was added.

The DHE algorithm was simplified to eliminate most dosing information as this is more appropriately managed on a patient-by-patient basis. Boxes 86 and 89-100 were eliminated. The algorithms that follow were renumbered accordingly.

Box 91, formerly box 108 had ergots removed as a prophylactic option for menstrual migraine.

### **Annotations**

- 22) Information related to neuroimaging was added (Silberstein, 2000).
- 51) The table listing drugs and related references has been moved to Appendix A.
- 75) Intranasal sumatriptan has been added as a treatment option (Francis, 2010).
- 85) Formerly Annotation #87, the dosing of DHE has been changed to 2mg/1000 mL with a limit of 2 mg/24 hours (current information in Epocrates).
- 91) Formerly Annotation #108, ergots were removed as a treatment option. Reference (D'Alessandro, 1983) was removed.
